The Allen County Coroner's Office was notified of the death of Dabe P. Maloley, male white 66 years of age, from Fort Wayne, Indiana. Dabe Maloley was the operator of a moped which was struck by a motor vehicle at the intersection of Hanna and Paulding roads, on Monday, April 8, 2019 at about 20:00 hours.

Dabe Maloley was transported from the scene to a local hospital where he remained until death was pronounced on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at about 17:00 hours. Contact has been made with the next of kin.

The Cause of Death is Blunt Force Trauma due to Motor Vehicle Crash and the Manner of Death is Accident.

Dabe Maloley is the 14<sup>th</sup> Fatal Traffic Crash of 2019 in Allen County, Indiana.

This incident remains under investigation by the Fort Wayne Police Department, the Allen County Coroner's Office.

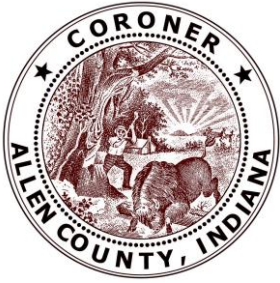
The Allen County Coroner's Office was notified of the fatal house fire located in the 10000 block of Muldoon Road, Fort Wayne, Indiana on Friday, April 12, 2019. The fire was reported at about 00:30 hours, with multiple county fire units being dispatched to the scene.

The decedent was located in the home and death was pronounced at 07:31 hours. The decedent was sent to the NEIFC and held for autopsy. The decedent was positively identified as Daniel L. McLaughlin, male white 74 years of age, from Fort Wayne, Indiana.

The Cause of Death is Thermal Burns and Smoke Inhalation and the Manner of Death is Accident.

This incident remains under investigation by the Fire Arson Specialized Team of Allen County, the Allen County Sheriff's Department and the Allen County Coroner's Office.

The Allen County Coroner's Office was contacted and advised of a deceased individual located in a field located near the 3300 block of Oakwood Drive, Fort Wayne, Indiana, on Saturday, April 13, 2019 at about 09:30 hours. .

An autopsy has been completed. The decedent has been identified but the next of kin has not been notified. Attempts to contact the next of kin will be made through our office. There were no signs of foul play noted at the autopsy.

The Cause of Death is Pending and the Manner of Death is Pending.
