The autopsy has been completed and notification has been made to the next of kin for the female victim that fled from a home in the 4000 block of Willshire Estates Drive, in Fort Wayne, on Tuesday, July 19, 2022, at approximately 08:13 hours. The decedent has been positively identified as Thin Thin Khaing female, Asian, 47 years of age from Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Thin Thin Khaing had been involved in a domestic dispute with her spouse before she was shot by her husband. She fled the residence to a neighbor's residence, who telephoned the police. Thin Thin Khaing was transported to a local hospital and was admitted. On Saturday, July 23, 2022, the Allen County Coroner's Office was notified that Thin Thin Khaing and died at 00:15 hours, on this date.

Cause of Death has been determined to be Multiple Gunshot Wounds and the manner of Death is Homicide.

Thin Thin Khaing is the 15th homicide for Fort Wayne, Allen County, Indiana, for 2022

The incident remains under investigation by the Fort Wayne Police Department, the Allen County Prosecutor's Office and the Allen County Coroner's Office.
